## Dwarf Judge's Report, Mapplewell, 13<sup>th</sup> December 2025

This was my first time judging Dwarfs and I admit I was quite overwhelmed at first as I am much less experienced than I am with Syrians. I am very thankful for the expert guidance of Susan and Jean who helped me through and offered invaluable insights and advice. I would not have managed without you! Susan also very kindly assessed me and I am pleased to say I have passed my first judging.

There were some lovely animals at this show and I awarded my BIS to a beautiful opal Campbell's male owned by Tristar, and RBIS to a normal Chinese male owned by Lilliput. These two received certificates of merit, as well as two BEW Chinese also owned by Lilliput. Congrats to Tristar and Lilliput on their wins.

My Class winners were as follows:

**Campbell Normal (1)** – D101, A nice solid male with a narrow head. Slightly thin fur, broken stripe on shoulders and orange hue to sides. 68pts

**Campbell Agouti (5)** – D201, Opal. A large male with a nice face and solid body. Nice arches but lacking ochre. 73pts, **BIS and COM**

**Campbell Self (2)** – D301, Albino. A nice clean white colour, long toenails. 70 ½ pts.

**WW Normal (3)** – D501, A nicely sized animal with decent type, however had uneven ticking and blurred arches. Dirty patch on chin. 70pts.

**WW Sapphire (2)** – D601, A large male with a nice face, however had a woolly coat and slightly bulging eyes. Small old wound on back lead to patchy coat. 70 ½ pts.

**WW Pearl (3)** – D702, Sapphire Pearl. A male with a slightly narrow face, a long body and moult. 68 ½ pts.

**Chinese Normal (6)** – D801, A slender male with a nice face and solidly built. Coat slightly open. 72 ½ pts, **RBIS & COM.**

**Chinese Sapphire (2)** – D901, A slightly beige-toned male with a nice triangle face and woolly coat. 72pts.

**Chinese Dom Spot (3)** – D1001, A sapphire dom spot male with a nice sapphire colour but slightly uneven spotting. 71pts.

**Chinese BEW (2)** – D1101, Both animals in this class were very similar in appearance and I presume brothers! Both had lovely sleek fur and were nicely clean and white. 72 1/2pts (+). D1101 and D1102 **COM.**

**Normal Roborovski (1)** – D1201 – A nice warm sandy colour but lacked body. Slight staining around scent gland. 68 ½ pts.

**Non-Standard (4)** – D2103 – Sapphire marbled WW. A compact male with a nice thick coat. 54 ½ pts.

Congrats to all winners and once again a huge thank you to Jean and Susan for stewarding for me and helping me learn and hopefully improve my judging next time!
